Councilmember McGrew nominated Councilmember Carlan as Chair of the Sanitation Committee. Councilmember Estes seconded the nomination, and it was approved unanimously. Councilmember Carlan called the meeting to order.

2. Organizational Discussion of the Committee

City Manager Billy Peppers listed goals for the committee to discuss. The goals include how to handle Requests for Proposals (RFP) for sanitation services, review of existing vendor and services provided, discuss issues with private streets, and discuss the City's roll off site. Assistant City Manager Nathan Ingram proposed allowing representatives of developments with issues or comments to attend committee meetings. Mr. Ingram discussed hydraulic spills and possible ways to have those cleaned. Mr. Peppers stated most of the hydraulic spills come from side arm loading trucks and staff would recommend that any new service provider not be allowed to use those trucks. Mr. Peppers further discussed items that are to be included in the RFP such as curb processes, how to schedule bulk item pickups, and responses for missed routes. The committee discussed having virtual meetings with each development separately to receive feedback on issues and concerns. Following these meetings, a town hall meeting can be scheduled to include residents. The committee requested to view surrounding jurisdiction's contracts for sanitation services and review the City's historic costs/rates. Councilmember Carlan proposed discussing breaking the City into multiple service areas. Councilmember Carlan requested to meet with the current sanitation vendor to discuss issues before meeting with each development. The committee set the next virtual meeting for Tuesday, June 8th at 2:00 pm.

3. Adjourn

Councilmember McGrew made a motion to adjourn. Councilmember Estes seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously.
