Sec. 6-388. - Tasting limitations.

• (a) Tastings shall be limited to malt beverages and wines only. Tastings shall be on limited occasions either when a customer requests a sample of a malt beverage or wine offered for sale within the premises or in conjunction with sampling designed to promote malt beverage or wine appreciation and education.

(b) No person shall consume more than 16 ounces in any one day on the premises. (Ord. No. 2014-07, § 2, 3-20-2014; Ord. No. 2015-05, § 2, 3-19-2015)

• Sec. 6-389. - Serving limitations.

(a) Malt beverages and/or wine products used in conjunction with tasting shall be opened and poured by the licensee or a person who has obtained a manager's permit as specified in this chapter.

(b) No open containers of malt beverages and/or wine shall be removed from the licensed premises.

(c) Holders of an ancillary tasting license shall not charge for tastings, but may accept donations for a charitable organization of their choice. Provided, however, that not more than two times per week for a period not to exceed four consecutive hours, the holder of an ancillary tasting license may hold promotional events (such as hosting beer or wine appreciation clubs, food pairings, and educational classes) and charge for attendance at such events.
