## **I. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The City of Canton (herein referred to as the City) is requesting proposal submissions from qualified vendors to provide construction services for the Right of Way Maintenance of City owned streets.

The Request for Proposals (RFP) describes the services in general that require scope of services, the selection process, and the minimum information that must be included with the proposal. Failure to submit information in accordance with the requirements and procedures listed herein may be cause for disqualification.

No interpretation or clarification of the meaning of the instructions or scope of services will be made orally except for general information that does not require clarification. ## III. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The City of Canton is seeking quotes from qualified firms that can fulfill right of way maintenance for City of Canton Streets.

The work areas are generally defined by city streets, city medians, and landscape areas. No work will be performed on private property.

The following narratives generally describe the specific Work Tasks and Frequency. Note that work tasks and frequency may vary within each city street segment or segments and landscape areas. The "work task narratives" are described in the following:

### A. Right of Way Mowing:

#### Work Tasks

Right of Way mowing work will be performed within City's right of way unless otherwise specified by the Public Works Director or his representative. Except as otherwise noted on the Exhibits or Spreadsheets, mowing areas are generally described as follows:

1. Local roads – the maximum cut width and overgrowth removal shall be with the city owned rights-of-way.
2. Mowing of Bermuda, zoysia or fescue along commercial or residential properties within right-of-way unless the homeowner or commercial owner maintains the right-of-way, which in this case mowing will not take place by the city's contractor. Cut depth shall be consistent with the grass areas on private property for any individual parcel.
3. Mowing will also occur in possible landscape areas as needed.
4. Includes trimming and/or herbicide treatment (at approved structures) at all signposts, fences, or other structures within the ROW.
5. Overgrowth vegetation shall be removed from all signposts, fences, guardrails or other structures within right-of-way.
6. Mowing height shall be no greater than 2 ½ inches when applicable.
7. Pick up of trash shall occur before each mowing operation. Additional trash pickups, if applicable, are identified in the work task and frequency spreadsheets.
8. Sidewalks, curbs, and other hard surfaces shall be kept free of leaves, litter, grass clippings, and debris resulting from mowing. The use of power blowers is acceptable; however, accumulations of debris must be removed from the site and not blown unto adjacent property, street surfaces, fence lines, or plant areas (rough of bedded). No trash, debris or plant material shall be blown or deposited into curb/gutters or storm drains by the Contractor. If material or debris is deposited into the curb/gutter or storm drain during mowing/trimming operations, the Contractor will remove it immediately by hand or mechanical means at no cost to the City of Canton.

## **B. Trash and Debris:**

Trash and debris and miscellaneous services will be performed within city and state right-of-way on the specified city street unless otherwise specified by the Director or his representative or as otherwise noted on the spreadsheets.

Trash and miscellaneous debris is defined as any organic or inorganic material that can readily be picked up by hand or mechanical device.

NOTE: The contractor shall provide the City of Canton the number of bags or the weight of all trash removed on a bi-weekly basis.

### **C. Maintenance of Hard Surfaces:**

Sediment and other material shall be removed from the curb line, catch basin inlet or gutter, concrete surfaces and pavers, island areas and sidewalks. Vegetation in sidewalks, pavers, curbs, gutters, and other hard surfaces can be removed by hand or through the use of an approved herbicide chemical.

Edging/trimming will include along walls, fences, foundations, behind curbs, sidewalks, paths, shrubs, guardrails, tree trunks, poles or other objects or structures within or bordering the mowing area within state or City right-of-way. The sidewalks, curbs, and other hard surfaces shall be kept free of leaves, litter, grass clippings and debris resulting from edging/trimming activities. The use of power blower is acceptable, however, accumulations of debris must be removed from the site and not blown unto adjacent property, street surfaces, fence lines or plant areas (rough or bedded).

### **D. Equipment:**

Each bidder/contractor must supply an equipment list that will be used on this project.

### **E. Changes:**

In the event a contract is awarded, the City may at any time during the contract periods make changes within the general scope of the contract and its technical provisions. If any such changes cause any increase or decrease in the Contractors cost of performing any part of the contract, an equitable adjustment shall be made in the contract price, or in the time of performance, or both, and a written agreement of such adjustment shall be made prior to proceeding with additional services. No additional services shall be performed until written authorization is received from the City. Nothing in this clause shall excuse the contractor from proceeding with the performance of the contract in accordance with its original terms and conditions and any approved changes.

- F.** The work required will be measured separately for payment unless otherwise specified. Payment for the items listed in the bid form, complete and accepted, will be made to the contractor based on the unit prices. Partial payments will be made on monthly statements based on a percent complete basis. Upon receipt and acceptance of the certification letter, final payment will be made.

**G. Termination of Contract:**

In the event that any of the provisions of this contract are violated by the Contractor, or by any subcontractors, the Owner may serve written notice upon the Contractor and the Surety of its intention to terminate the contract. Such notices shall contain the reasons for such intention to terminate the contract. If within ten (10) days after such notice upon the Contractor, such violation or delay has not ceased or a satisfactory arrangement of corrections have not been made, the contract shall, upon the expiration of said ten (10) days, cease and terminate. In the event of any such termination, the Owner shall immediately serve notice thereof upon the Surety and shall have the right to take over and perform the contract; provided, however, that if the Surety does not commence performance thereof within ten (10) days from the date of the mailing to same to complete by Contractor or by force account and at the expense of the Contractor, the Contractor and his Surety shall be liable to the Owner for any excess cost occasioned the Owner thereby, and in such event the Owner may take possession of and utilize in completing the work, such materials, appliances, and plant as may be on the site of the work and necessary therefore.

**H. Contract Period:**

The term of contract shall be a period of seven (7) months beginning April 1, 2026 and ending on November 1, 2026. This contract may be extended on (1) or more additional years if both parties concur. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and re-advertise. The contract may be terminated by the City of Canton at its sole discretion within a 10 day written notice. Written notice may also take place in the form of an email. If the agreement is terminated, Contractor shall be paid in accordance with the terms of the agreement.

#### **IV. SUBMITTAL REQUIRMENTS/PROPSAL FORMAT**

- A. One (1) hard copies of the Proposal and one (1) electronic copy (pdf) on a USB flash drive must be received by the City of Canton on or before the due date as specified on the RFP Cover Page. The city cannot be responsible for the lack of receipt of proposals by the date and time specified.

- C. Submittals will NOT be accepted or considered after the deadline. **E-mailed or faxed copies will not be accepted.**
- D. The Proposal must demonstrate specific expertise in the elements of work described herein. Proposals should be bound with the name of the From or Vendor and name of the Project visible on the outside cover. To allow the selection committee sufficient time to properly review all documents in their entirety, each proposal will be limited to 20 pages. The Title Page, Table of Contents, Letter of Transmittal, Section Dividers, Resumes, and Additional Items will not count against the page limits. The Proposals shall contain the Following:
  - 1. SECTION 1 – INFORMATION: The Proposal shall include background information of the firm including its address, history, size, services offered and related information.
  - 2. SECTION 2 – IDENTIFICAION OF PROPSEER: The Proposal shall include the names, background information, email addresses and phone numbers for key staff that are proposed to be involved it the project.

3. SECTION 3 – PROJECT OVERVIEW AND APPROACH: The Proposal shall demonstrate the Firm’s understanding of and acknowledgement of the Scope of Work. Required content will be:
  - a. Detailed work plan and schedule for installation
  - b. Details of all warranties provided
  
4. SECTION 4 – CLIENT REFERENCES: The Proposal shall include information on three (3) similar projects that the firms(s) have completed in the last ten (10) years.
  
5. SECTION 5 – ADDITIONAL ITEMS: The following items must be included with each proposal received. Failure to include these items may be the cause for disqualification.
  - a. Copy of current business license’
  - b. Completed Contractor Information Form, Conflict of Interest Certification, E-Verify Federal Work Authorization, and Vendor Statement of Tax Status (found at end of this RFP).
  - c. Proof of Commercial insurance, voting bodily injury, death, and property damage with a single limit not less than one (\$1,000,000) dollar.
  - d. Prior to receiving a “Notice to Award”, the City will require the awardee to submit a Certification of Insurance and Workers Compensation.

## **V. PROPOSED CONTRACT FEES**

- A. Submit one copy of your cost proposal in a separate sealed envelope, clearly marked. Proposals that do not provide costs in a sealed envelope may be considered non-responsive and subject to disqualification. Include itemized costs for all services to be delivered. Costs should be identified as unit costs on an as needed basis for each type of service proposed. The city reserves the right to contact proposers on cost and scope clarification at any time throughout the selection and/or negotiation process.

## VI. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

A. The City of Canton will review and evaluate proposals based on the following factors:

1. Functional and Technical Requirements

Degree to which the proposal meets the requirements of the RFP. Exceptions to required features and functions considered essential by the City may result in disqualification of a proposal.

2. Proposer's Previous Performance Qualifications

- a. Experience with other projects similar in scope
- b. References

3. Costs

Competitiveness of proposer's total pricing. Pricing will not be the sole determining factor in awarding the contract. Should the City determine that a Firm does not meet the qualifications as required by this RFP, it may return cost proposal unopened to the proposer.

B. Selection Process:

- 1. Proposals will be evaluated based on the written response to selection criteria listed and the cost proposals provided. After receipt and review of proposals, the City may elect to conduct interviews for some or all firms.
- 2. It is anticipated that a contract for the prescribed services will be entered into with the firm that in the opinion of the City offers the most favorable combination of qualifications, approach, and pricing. Please note that the selection is a value-based selection, and the lowest cost proposal is not guaranteed to be the selected firm.

### C. Award of Contract

1. The City anticipates recommending to City Council, the award of this contract, with a Notice of Award being issued soon thereafter. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals submitted, to waive any informalities in the proposals submitted, and to award a contract only when it appears to be in the best interest of the City.

## **VII. SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

- A. This RFP does not commit the City to procure or award a contract for work or to compensate Proposers for proposal preparation expense. All costs to prepare a response to this RFP shall be borne by the proposer.
- B. All information submitted in response to this RFP shall become the property of the City, and as such, may be subject to public review as public record.
- C. The City reserves the right to cancel, modify, supplement, add to, delete from or change any part or aspect of this project if it is believed to be in the best interest of the City.
- D. The City reserves the right to request additional data, information or clarification pertinent to this solicitation after the submittal date, provided that such information is germane to evaluation of the firm's qualifications. However, the City shall not be required to request missing information from the submittal which may cause them to be considered non-responsive.
- E. The City shall provide the release of all public information concerning the project, including selection announcements and contract awards. Those desiring to release information to the public must receive prior written approval through the City.
- F. Members of the firm or vendor, their agents, lobbyists, attorneys and others shall not contact members of the City Council, any employee of the City other than the contact person or the Selection Committee regarding this project or process. Any such contact shall be grounds for automatic disqualification of the firm's submittal.
- G. The City, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject any and all submittals, waive any and all irregularities, and disregard any and all

nonconforming or counter submittals. H. The City may accept or reject any or all information submitted as part of the RFP.

I. All proposals will be held in confidence until award.

### **VIII. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY**

The City of Canton is an equal employment opportunity employer. The City endeavors to do business with firms sharing the City's commitment to equal opportunity and will not do business with any firm that discriminates on the basis of race, religion, color, ancestry, age, gender, sexual orientation, disability, medical condition or place of birth.

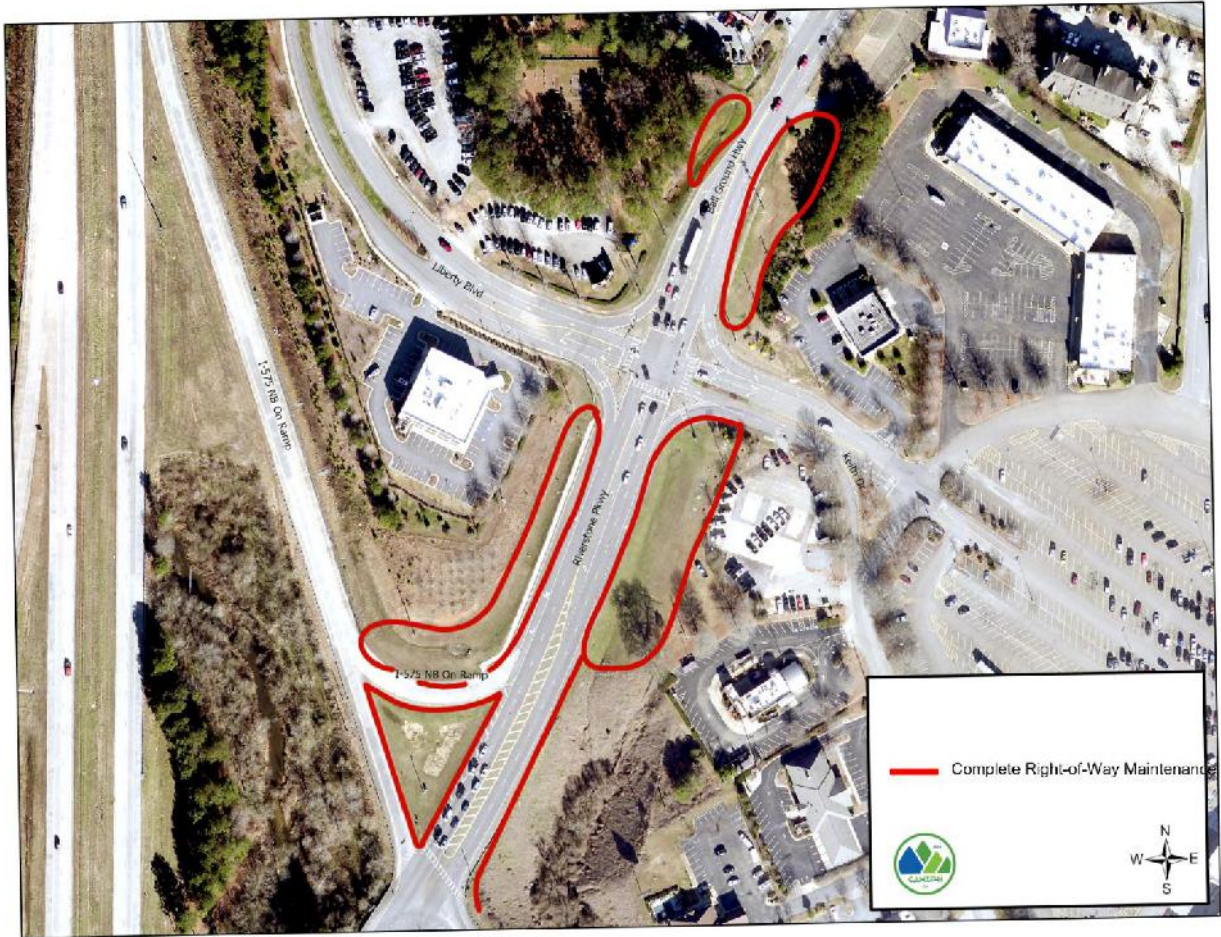
