Public Hearing and Discussion of Annual Update to Capital Improvements Plan and 5 Year Short Term Work Plan for Impact Fees.

Summary:

The City of Canton is required to submit an annual update to Georgia DCA and ARC for its impact fee program. Canton's annual update deadline is February 28, 2025. To meet this deadline, the City must conduct a public hearing and pass a resolution to transmit for Georgia DCA and ARC review and comment. Staff has advertised to conduct the required public hearing on Thursday, November 7, 2024. At the November 21, 2024 City Council meeting, a Resolution to Transmit will be on the agenda for approval. The state review period is 50 days. After the review period, the City of Canton will have to approve a resolution to adopt the annual update CIE and 5 Year STWP Addendum. After adoption, the staff is required to submit executed Resolution to Adopt to Georgia DCA and ARC prior to February 28, 2025. Failure to meet the February 28, 2025 deadline would result in Canton losing
"Qualified Local Government Status." Loss of QLG status would mean the City would not be eligible for grant or loan funding administered through Georgia DCA and GEFA.
