Exhibit A: Supplementary Scope of Services

Current Scope of Services

Black & Veatch (BV) was tasked by the City of Canton to support water system improvements identified in the 2018 Master Plan to provide improved flow to the 1292 Pressure Zone, including:

• Design a water main replacement project for the crossing of I-575 along State Route (SR) 20 located east of the City center.

As part of this project, BV has provided: project administration and management, surveying, permitting, detailed design and bidding assistance.

Supplementary Scope of Services

BV completed the detailed design and permitting of the project in February 2025. Bids were advertised on February 27, 2025, with bids due on April 3, 2025. It is anticipated that the notice to proceed for construction will be issued in June 2025. The construction time allowed for Substantial Completion is 180 days, and the time allowed for Final Completion readiness for final payment is 210 days from the date of commencement.

BV is requesting approval of the following supplementary services related to construction administration of the project that were not included in the original scope of services.

- i. Attend up to eight monthly construction progress meetings, which includes a site visit and preparation of monthly meeting summaries.
- ii. Engineer of Record will provide two inspections: one at Substantial Completion and one at Final Completion. Inspections will include:
 - a. Preparation of a punch list.
 - b. Issue Final Certificate of Completion
- iii. Review submittals and shop drawings and maintain a submittal log.
 - a. Assumes up to 30 submittals.
- iv. Review and respond to RFIs related to the contract documents and maintain an RFI log.
 - a. Assumes up to 10 RFIs.
- v. Review change order requests and maintain a change management log.
 - a. Assumes up to 2 change orders.
- vi. Prepare project record documents, incorporating Contractor's drawing markups.
- vii. Warranty period inspection: up to two inspections have been assumed during the warranty period.

It is assumed that the construction administration services will be provided for up to nine months, which includes 7 months for active construction followed by up to two months of project closeout activities, which will include: finalizing record drawings, payment certificates and warranty inspections.

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Exhibit B Estimated Labor Hours and Associated Fee

The Scope of Services and the associated fee of \$86,845 are authorized upon execution of this task order.
