Summary:

Discussing our RFP for additions to our existing City Park security camera systems, and bringing our existing security camera systems into one viewable platform. We received 8 bids for the project.
Our committee for the RFP included Information Technology, Police, City Management, Communications and Parks Department. The Police Department prefers that we integrate into Flock's platform as our Uniform Patrol Division already uses their platform to view our network of Flock LPR traffic camera system.
We have chosen Flock as our preferred vendor. All of the other vendors offered a purchase model in which we would own the equipment but be responsible for maintenance and upgrades.
Flock offers a subscription model in which is scalable and includes all maintenance and upgrades.

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

The City of Canton (herein referred to as the City) is requesting proposal submissions from qualified vendors to install and/or replace outdated security cameras at various City Buildings, Parks, or other locations as described and listed in the scope of work to follow.

This Request for Proposals (RFP) describes the services in general, the required scope of services, the selection process, and the minimum information that must be included with the proposal. Failure to submit information in accordance with the requirements and procedures listed herein may be cause for disqualification.

Questions and Clarifications

Any questions regarding this RFP must be submitted by e-mail to the group listed below no later than the date indicated on the Calendar of Events as listed on the cover page of this RFP. Every request for such interpretation should be in writing, submitted by e-mail, contain the RFP# as indicated on the cover sheet within the subject line of the email, and addressed to the review committee as shown below. To be given consideration, questions must be received by the due date for questions. Answers to the questions will be posted as an Addendum to the RFP. No interpretation or clarification of the meaning of the instructions or scope of services will be made orally except for general information that does not require clarification. All clarifications and any supplemental instructions will be posted on the City of Canton website at the following address:

II. PRE-SUBMITTAL MEETING

A mandatory pre-submittal meeting will be held on Thursday, May 30, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall, 110 Academy Street, Canton, GA 30114. At this meeting, City staff will discuss the scope of work, general contract issues and respond to questions from the attendees. All firms interested in this Project are required to attend the Pre-Submittal Meeting. Vendors may schedule site-inspections subsequent this meeting. These site-inspections will be for inspection only and questions regarding this RFP will not be answered during these inspections. City Staff will not be available for meetings or to respond to individual inquiries regarding the project scope outside of these meetings.

III. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The vendor shall provide licensed, qualified personnel to design and install the security camera system according to the following specifications and conditions:

- A. System Requirements. The total number of cameras is not set. The City is looking for a reasonable recommendation based on the following system requirements:
- Must provide full-color recording;
 - Must provide fields of view that cover specified areas in the attached figures;
 - Must provide camera fields of coverage of sufficient resolution and sensitivity to allow for recognition of individuals through facial features under normal weather conditions;
 - Must be scalable to allow for future expansion;
 - Must allow for secured remote access;
 - Must provide minimum retention times for footage of 30 days;
 - Must provide wireless on-site storage utilizing a central network video recorder;
 - Must minimally provide coverage of entrances, parking lots, and coverage specific to location figures provided;
 - Must include warranty on all system components;
 - Must include user training and documentation for the system.
- B. System specifications and options. For the proposed system, the vendor shall also specify the following:
- The resolution and frames-per-second rate capabilities;
 - The level of system cybersecurity;
 - Any additional server or hardware required;

- Any options for tamper resistance, motion detection, night vision and the associated cost;
- Any options for self-contained power supply back up and the associated cost.

C. Installation Requirements:

The vendor will provide appropriate mounting hardware (as needed) for the manufacturer's recommended installation of the equipment.

The vendor is required to determine circuit availability wherever circuitry may be required on existing facilities and is not to assume that any drawing or documentation exists to aid.

The vendor will provide all labor, materials, tools, equipment, technologies, and specialized techniques necessary for installing equipment as described above.

D. Time To Completion:

Project must be completed the earlier of; within 180 days of contract execution or June 30,2025.

E. Locations: See Attached Maps for existing and proposed installation points.

IV. SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS/PROPOSAL FORMAT

- A. One (1) hard copies of the Proposal and one (1) electronic copy (pdf) on a USB flash drive must be received by the City of Canton on or before the due date as specified on the RFP Cover Page. The City cannot be responsible for the lack of receipt of proposals by the date and time specified.

- C. Submittals will NOT be accepted or considered after the deadline. **e-mailed or faxed copies will not be accepted.**
- D. The Proposal must demonstrate specific expertise in the elements of work described herein. Proposals should be bound with the name of the Firm or

Vendor and name of the Project visible on the outside cover. To allow the selection committee sufficient time to properly review all documents in their entirety, each proposal will be limited to 20 pages. The Title Page, Table of Contents, Letter of Transmittal, Section Dividers, Resumes, and Additional Items will not count against the page limits. The Proposal shall contain the following:

1. SECTION 1 - INFORMATION: The Proposal shall include background information of the firm including its address, history, size, services offered and related information.
2. SECTION 2 - IDENTIFICATION OF PROPOSER: The Proposal shall include the names, background information, email addresses and phone numbers for key staff that are proposed to be involved in the project.
3. SECTION 3 - PROJECT OVERVIEW AND APPROACH: The Proposal shall demonstrate the Firm's understanding of and acknowledgement of the Scope of Services. Required content will be:
 - a. Description of system and all components
 - b. Manufacturer's specifications
 - c. Detailed work plan and schedule for installation
 - d. Detail of all warranties provided
4. SECTION 4 - CLIENT REFERENCES: The Proposal shall include information on five (5) similar projects that the firm(s) have completed in the last ten (10) years.
5. SECTION 5 - ADDITIONAL ITEMS: The following items must be included with each proposal received. Failure to include these items may be cause for disqualification.
 - a. Copy of current business license;
 - b. Completed Contractor Information Form, Conflict of Interest Certification, E-Verify Federal Work Authorization, and Vendor Statement of Tax Status (found at end of this RFP);
 - c. Proof of commercial insurance, covering bodily injury, death, and property damage with a single limit not less than one million (\$1,000,000) dollars;
 - d. Prior to receiving a "Notice to Award", the City will require the awardee to submit a Certification of Insurance and Workers Compensation.

V. PROPOSED CONTRACT FEES

- A. **Submit one copy of your cost proposal in a separate sealed envelope, clearly marked. Proposals that do not provide costs in a sealed envelope may be considered non-responsive and subject to disqualification.** Include itemized costs for all services to be delivered. Costs should be identified as unit costs on an as needed per service basis for each type of service proposed. The City reserves the right to contact proposers on cost and scope clarification at any time throughout the selection and/or negotiation process.
- B. Cost proposals should include and be broken down by at least:
1. Cost of equipment
 2. Cost of labor to install
 3. Cost and any ongoing fees associated with training
 4. Cost of any multi-year maintenance/service contracts
 5. Cost estimate per general location would be preferable (e.g., City Hall, Etowah River Park, etc.)

VI. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

- A. The City of Canton will review and evaluate proposals based on the following factors:
1. Functional and Technical Requirements

Degree to which the proposal meets the functional and technical requirements of the RFP. Exceptions to required features and functions considered essential by the City may result in disqualification of a proposal.
 2. Proposer's Previous Performance Qualifications
 - a. Experience with other projects similar in scope.
 - b. References.
 3. Costs

Competitiveness of proposer's total pricing. Pricing will not be the sole determining factor in awarding the contract. Should the City and its Review Committee determine that a Firm does not meet the qualifications as required by this RFP, it may return the cost proposal unopened to the proposer.

B. Selection Process:

1. Proposals will be evaluated based on the written response to selection criteria listed and the cost proposals provided. After receipt and review of proposals, the City may elect to conduct interviews for some or all firms.
2. It is anticipated that a contract for the prescribed services will be entered into with the firm that in the opinion of the City offers the most favorable combination of qualifications, approach, and pricing. Please note that the selection is a value-based selection and the lowest cost proposal is not guaranteed to be the selected firm.

C. Award of Contract

1. The City anticipates recommending to City Council, the award of this contract in July or August of 2024, with a Notice of Award being issued soon thereafter. The City reserves the right to reject any and all proposals submitted, to waive any informalities in the proposals submitted, and to award a contract only when it appears to be in the best interest of the City.

VIII. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- A. This RFP does not commit the City to procure or award a contract for work or to compensate Proposers for proposal preparation expense. All costs to prepare a response to this RFP shall be borne by the proposer.
- B. All information submitted in response to this RFP shall become the property of the City, and as such, may be subject to public review as public record.
- C. The City reserves the right to cancel, modify, supplement, add to, delete from or change any part or aspect of this project if it is believed to be in the best interest of the City.
- D. The City reserves the right to request additional data, information or clarification pertinent to this solicitation after the submittal date, provided that such information is germane to evaluation of the firm's qualifications.

However, the City shall not be required to request missing information from the submittal which may cause them to be considered non-responsive.

- E. The City shall provide the release of all public information concerning the project, including selection announcements and contract awards. Those desiring to release information to the public must receive prior written approval through the City.
- F. Members of the firm or vendor, their agents, lobbyists, attorneys and others shall not contact members of the City Council, any employee of the City other than the contact person or the Selection Committee regarding this project or process. Any such contact shall be grounds for automatic disqualification of the firm's submittal.
- G. The City, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject any and all submittals, waive any and all irregularities, and disregard any and all non-conforming or counter submittals.
- H. The City may accept or reject any or all information submitted as part of the RFP.
- I. All proposals will be held in confidence until award.

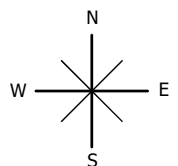

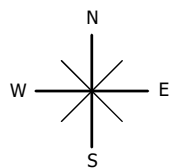

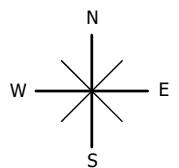

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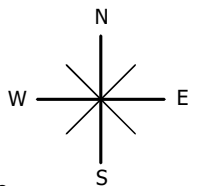


Downtown Canton - Cherokee County Courthouse Area

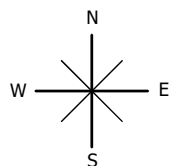
